Cell phone call and data reception is poor in many areas of the Hocking Hills, but the Lodge does have free wi-fi, so attendees will be able to use the wi-fi to stay connected. No need to bring air mattresses or bedding (unless you want to bring your own special pillow or blanket), it's all provided.

At Winter Camp, the Youth asked to pack and donate snack bags for kids who may have food insecurities, which is a fantastic community service initiative for our Summer Camp. I have asked for donations from Granges across the state and we have already received some items; please speak to your Grange about our plans and ask them to donate kid-friendly, individually wrapped snacks to our community service project (like snack crackers, juice boxes, fruit cups, granola bars, etc.). This is a great opportunity for subordinate Granges to partner with the Youth to help support our community service responsibilities. Please bring items to camp that you collect.

Please complete your registration paperwork and return to the Ohio State Grange office as soon as possible- we need it by May 31st to have your camp t-shirt available for you at camp. If you miss the May 31st deadline, it's not too late to attend camp, just contact me so I can keep a correct headcount and work with the State Grange office on processing the paperwork and payment.
